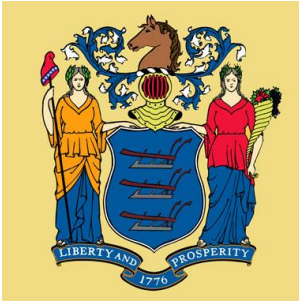

NJ's 1st Sustainable Site Plan Ordinance



Recently, the **City of Camden** (a General Code client) passed New Jersey's first Sustainability Site Plan Ordinance. It is one of just a handful of sustainability ordinances passed across the country that addresses environment justice and cumulative impacts.

Before this ordinance, a developer was required to report on how it alone would affect air quality, not taking into consideration that adjacent development might also be affecting air quality.
